

Moving Exchange to The Cloud

Large healthcare network needed assistance in moving Exchange to Microsoft 365

OVERVIEW

This healthcare network has roots dating back more than 100 years and offers the services of 100+ providers and 20 specialties with 5 community clinics all supported by a critical access hospital on their main campus.

SOLUTION

It is critical that a migration to Microsoft 365 cloud services be carefully planned and performed by a team with experience in managing change, a framework for reducing risk, and a methodology that has been time-tested but also continually improved. Prepare & Pilot: Communicating to end users to prepare them for migration, performing pilot migrations to vet processes and capture any outstanding modifications to the plan or environment.

Migrate: Finally, the Oakwood Team executed the mailbox migrations and ensured end-users and their data is secure and compliant with governance in the target environment.
